 may not be placed in the appropriate faith criterion. This is likely to affect your child's chance of being offered a place.
- For a Reception Year Admission in the normal admissions round for the Year 2024-25, the completed SIF, together with all supporting documents, should be returned to the school by **15 January 2024.**
- For an In-Year Admission in the Year 2024-25, the completed SIF, together with all supporting documents, should be returned to the school as soon as possible.
- If you are applying to more than one Catholic school, you will need to fill out a separate SIF for each school.
- For a Reception Year Admission in the normal round, you **must** also complete the local authority Common Application Form (CAF). The SIF is not valid without the CAF.

**** NOTE: The governing body of The Marist Catholic Primary School, West Byfleet has agreed the following statement in order to clarify how its faith-based oversubscription criteria will be interpreted for admissions in 2024-25 IF a) churches are closed or attendance at church was affected due to a pandemic such as COVID19 (or similar) <u>AND</u> b) The Bishops' Conference of England & Wales announced a suspension of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. If this situation applies during the year prior to the closing date for applications for 2024-25, and if a parent/carer attended Mass at a certain frequency at a particular parish / parishes prior to the obligation suspension, then they will be considered to have attended Mass in that parish / parishes at the same frequency since that time. This would remain the case until the Sunday obligation is reintroduced by the Bishops. <i>NB: If the above situation does not arise during the year prior to the closing date for 2024-25 applications, this note is to be ignored.</i>				
Applications from Catechumens or Candidates for Reception - evidence required: If application is being made for a place at the school where the parent/carer is a Catechumen or a Candidate for reception into the Catholic Church, evidence of their being a member of the catechumenate of a Catholic Church or a candidate for reception will be required. Proof of acceptance into the catechumenate, and evidence for a candidate, should be by a confirmatory letter from the appropriate priest. This evidence should be provided at the same time as this form is returned to the school.				
Applications for children who are members of an Orthodox Church - evidence required: If application is being made for a place at the school where the child is a member of an Orthodox Church, evidence of membership will be required. Membership is normally evidenced by a certificate of baptism/reception into the Orthodox Church. If that is not available, then a letter confirming membership of the applicable Orthodox Church, signed by the appropriate priest, will be required. The certificate of baptism/reception from the authorities of that Church or the letter from the priest confirming membership should be provided at the same time as this form is returned to the school.				
Applications for children of other Christian denominations - evidence required: If application is being made for a place at the school where the child is a member of another Christian denomination, either a certificate of baptism (where applicable) or a letter confirming membership of that Christian denomination, and signed by the appropriate minister of religion, will be required. The certificate of baptism or confirmatory letter should be provided at the same time as this form is returned to the school.				
Applications for children of other faiths - evidence required: If application is being made for a place at the school where the child is a member of another faith, a letter confirming membership of that faith, and signed by the appropriate faith leader, will be required. The letter should be provided at the same time as this form is returned to the school.				
Children with Exceptional and Compelling needs: Parents/carers wishing to have Exceptional and Compelling Need considered with their application (criterion 2 or 10 of the Admissions Policy) must submit original independent professional evidence which explains clearly why it is essential to attend The Marist Catholic Primary School. The supporting evidence from the qualified professional must detail fully the child's needs and address the reason why these needs can only be met at The Marist. (The evidence should be addressed to the Chair of Governors and either posted to the school by recorded delivery or handed to the school office and a receipt received). For entry into the Reception Year in September 2024, the evidence should be received by the applications closing date of 15 January 2024.
