WAVE 1	Core Provision Level 1 Funding
<ul> <li>Curriculum;</li> <li>Children study a broad balanced curriculum.</li> <li>Children study English and Maths in the mornings.</li> <li>Topics are taught within their classes in afternoons.</li> <li>PE is taught both inside and outside in a fully accessible playground and field area.</li> <li>Music is taught in our Music room.</li> <li>Children broadly follow the same curriculum.</li> <li>Mastery approach to teaching</li> <li>Pre-teaching of vocabulary</li> <li>Read, Write, Inc phonics programme delivered across EYFS and Key stage 1.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Pastoral;</li> <li>Children are assigned to a classroom with a class teacher.</li> <li>The Class teacher and staff in each year group are present for collective worship and to deal with any arising concerns that children have.</li> <li>All children follow Zones of Regulation in their PSHE provision.</li> <li>Each Key stage has assemblies and services regularly.</li> <li>Class teachers review progress and refer to others if needed.</li> <li>Friendship benches are on all playgrounds and children are taught how to use them.</li> <li>All children have weekly PSHE sessions to support their emotional wellbeing.</li> <li>All classrooms have visual timetables outlining the school day.</li> <li>All staff use an emotion coaching approach to support behavior and regulation of emotions.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Staffing;</li> <li>The SENDCo and LSA team are utilised to run some provisions to reduce gaps in learning.</li> <li>Short term academic and social interventions are run by Learning Support Assistants.</li> <li>Learning Support Assistants are deployed across the school where needed.</li> <li>A dedicated Speech and Language team.</li> <li>Two ELSAs</li> <li>A dedicated SEND team consisting of SENDCo and SENDCo Assistant</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Environmental/Facilities;</li> <li>Children have access to the school site, allocated to their key stage.</li> <li>Doors are open and all classrooms have playground access.</li> <li>Children have access to the Library, music rooms and Nurture room.</li> <li>All stairs have handrails and we have access to a lift should children require it.</li> <li>All children have access to an adventure playground and a garden with a pond.</li> <li>We have a two children's disabled toilets, upstairs and downstairs with shower and hoist if needed.</li> <li>Low sensory displays, reduction in bells and transitions.</li> <li>Inclusive Catholic Ethos of school and environment</li> <li>A dedicated medical treatment room for children with medical needs.</li> <li>Staff have had Evac training.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Staffing;</li> <li>ELSA's are available 5 days per week and used for varying periods of times.</li> <li>Specialist teacher consultants</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Environmental/Facilities;</li> <li>The SEND office and rooms are located near the key stage 1 playground.</li> <li>The low sensory room is available for children for breakout or timetabled use.</li> </ul>
